Version Control Tool

- Tool which allows users (National Team members and developers) to share changes performed to the EUROMOD model.
- Screenshots (work-in-progress) presented during the last Annual meeting.
- Development finished and tool fully functional.
- Trainings provided to developers and National Teams members by JRC.



Version Control Tool

- Now fully functional:
 - Model stored at JRC for EU Member States.
 - Safe (files are encrypted before transmissing them).
 - User-friendliness improved.
 - Speed improved.
 - Used for the Internal Release.
 - 50 users: developers from UoE and JRC, National Teams.



University of Essex and Joint Research Centre started the procedure to license EUROMOD as Open Source.

Still work in progress but close to the end.




• Licenses:

Model	CC (Creative Common) BY 4.0
Source code of executable and libraries	EUPL (European Union Public License) version 1.2
Other components (including compiled software)	End-user license agreement (no Open Source)



• Advantages:





- Source code will be uploaded to a platform on the Internet several times per year.
- Public release will be announced.
