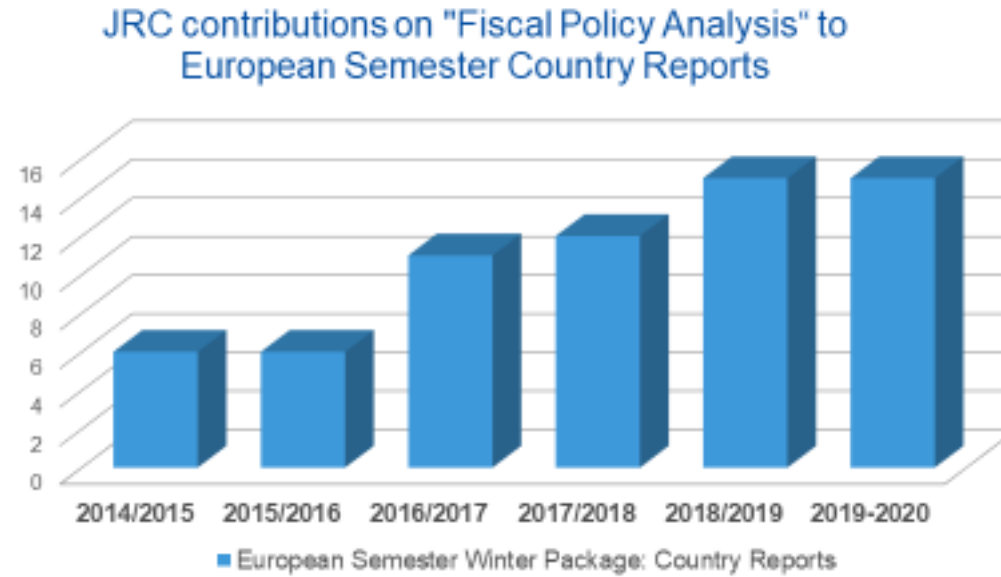

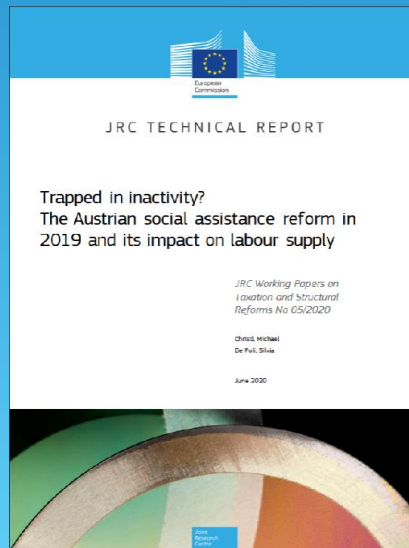
i. Policy support – European Semester

...some examples

- **Austria:** Financial disincentives to work longer hours + distributional and equity effects of introducing an explicit price for CO2
- **Germany:** distributional and equity effects of introducing a CO2 price
- **Spain:** Analysis of income guarantee schemes + Child poverty in Spain
- **France:** Assessing the redistributive impact of some measures favourable to households' disposable income
- **Italy:** Extended tax credit on employees' personal income taxes in Italy
Shifting taxes from labour to property in Italy: EUROMOD-QUEST simulation

+ technical assistance: Greece + Lithuania, Slovakia and Romania
