What's new?

Compared to the previous release (16.39+ beta), this one includes the following updates/changes:

POLICIES AND FUNTIONALITIES

- New 2024 policy systems for all countries
- New uprating indices and exchange rates for 2024, and updates/corrections for previous years
- Inclusion of consumption taxes (VAT and excises) for all countries for years 2010 (2012 for HR) and 2019-2024, with the following new elements:
 - A new policy (tco_cc) at the end of the spine of each country.
 - o **A new table (Consumption Taxes)**, placed under Country Tools
 - Four new add-ons: CT_XBASE, CT_XCES, CT_XCIS, CT_XCQ
- Addition of a new global extension: Benefit Calibration Adjustment (BCA)
- Redesign and harmonisation of adjustments of social assistance benefits for all countries, using Benefit Take-up Adjustment (BTA) or Benefit Calibration Adjustment (BCA) extensions, leading to more transparency and flexibility for the user
- Bug fixes and improvements in all country models

DATA

- New datasets (149) containing all the SILC-derived variables (2010 and 2019-2022) + expenditure shares for 193 COICOP categories matched from HBS (2010 and 2015). These datasets allow for all the traditional EUROMOD simulations (direct taxes, social insurance contributions and cash benefits) plus the new simulations of consumption taxes.
- New country-specific training data for all countries, roughly mimicking the income distribution of each country and including also expenditure shares for the simulation of consumption taxes.
- New training dataset for Simpleland, similar to the country-specific datasets [simulation of consumption taxes not yet available]
- New 2022 SILC-only input data for BG and FI
