A summary of 2021- Overview

- 2021 is the first year post-transition.
- The learning process is completed and JRC/ESTAT now fully responsible for the last sets of tasks transferred:
 - 27 countries (model and data preparation)
 - Software development and management
 - Granting access, dissemination and training
 - Reports and web statistics

A summary of 2021 – Model releases

- EUROMOD version I3.0+ released in January 2020 as **open source**
 - 2018 data, 2020 policies
- Beta versions of the model **freely downloadable from website:**
 - EUROMOD I3.40+ (ESTAT release) released in May 2021
 - EUROMOD I3.86+, released in September 2021, contains 2019 data, 2021 systems
- First software released by the JRC (3.4.3) freely downloadable from website
- EUROMOD SILC Database (EMSD) implemented in 10 countries
- Public release planned for December 2021/January 2022

A summary of 2021 – Governance

- Scientific Advisory Board (SAB) met in November 2020
 - Antoine Bozio (Chair), Francesco Figari, Bent Greve, Chrysa Leventi, Holly Sutherland, Gerlinde Verbist, Loukas Stemitsiotis (Chair of the Steering Group)
 - Scientific report published in website (<https://euromod-web.jrc.ec.europa.eu/overview/governance>)
 - Details on SAB recommendations will be discussed tomorrow
- Steering Group met in February 2021
 - Representatives from partner DGs, chair of the SAB

A summary of 2021 – Training and dissemination activities

- 3-day training courses organised in April and October 2021.
- Both courses took place online (EU Academy platform)
- 30+ participants in April, similar figures expected for October
- EUROMOD website: continuously updated, section on projects and publications to be added soon

Project management

- Change in the access to EUROMOD input datasets
 - Access to S-CIRCABC granted only to the data manager/principal investigator as indicated in a valid Research Project Proposal (RPP) for the use of EU SILC
 - Responsibility of the data manager/principal investigator to share data with other researchers named in the RPP, after collecting and sending to JRC the individual data access forms
 - Automatic access to all the data releases until expiration of the RPP
- Amendments of FWCs for countries that will start using the EMSD from 2022
- Change in EUROMOD project leader at the JRC
