  - G2: BE, BG, CY, HU, IE, IT, MT, PL
- JRC shadowing the remaining countries
- Preliminary country allocation

# Memorandum of Understanding

- Signed by Essex, JRC, ESTAT, sets the main principles of the transfer:
  - The EC intends to uphold (or improve) the quality of the model content
  - The UoE and the EC intend to collaborate to the maintenance of a coherent single version of EUROMOD
  - National Teams are expected to continue to play an important role after the transition process is completed
  - Maintain dissemination and user support activities

# Governance (Possible organisation)

- Steering committee
  - Administrative body
  - Budgetary supervision
  - Evaluate scientific long term objectives
  - Mostly Internal to the Commission (financing DGs) + Members of the academic community
- Advisory Board
  - Scientific body
  - Reviews recent developments and performances
  - Identification of future priorities
  - Mostly Scientific/Independent membership



# Long term EM development

- Ensure that only a single and coherent version of EUROMOD exists
- Various scenarios analysed
- Euromod Technical Committee: Essex and JRC + Other institutions interested in EUROMOD development
