


- Continuously updated
- Captures interactions within the tax-benefit system
- Complex policy reforms (e.g. revenue-neutral tax shifts)
- EU-wide policy reform proposals
- Flexibility to combine with other models (e.g. QUEST)
- Learning about tax and social benefit codes ...



2. JRC use of the EUROMOD model during the past year

• Use in the **European Semester policy cycle**: exante assessment of both hypothetical reforms and enacted reforms. <u>Growing focus on distributional aspects.</u>



- **Development of extensions of the model** (joint work with academia) also used for policy analysis.
 - Labour supply effect of tax and social benefit reforms
 - Dynamic scoring & automatic stabilisation: interaction between EUROMOD and QUEST
 - Wealth and capital related taxation (EWIGE project).
 - Fiscal impact of migration.
 - Tax evasion and income under-reporting
 - Distributional impact of energy taxation (ITT)
 - Use administrative data in EUROMOD (Technical assistance to Greece)



3. Ongoing & future projects

Use for technical assistance to Member States

- Close partnership with Structural Reform Service of the European Commission (Secretariat General).

Dialogue with the Member States in EC Committees

- Tax expenditures in capital taxation
- Energy taxation

EUROMOD extensions and thematic analyses

- Broadening interaction between EUROMOD and QUEST models
- Impact of pension tax expenditures & OLG modelling
- Long-term consequences of changing labour markets
